

REGULATION FOR THE EXERCISE OF THE RIGHT TO REPORT

Article 1 - Scope of Application

1. This regulation rules the methods and limits for the exercise of the right to report with specific and exclusive reference to the event called Dream World Cup 2018 (hereinafter referred to in this Regulation as "Event"), for the communication operators.
2. This regulation also establishes the procedures to enter the sports facility for the registration of the Event by the communication operators, as well as the requirements for the accreditation of the same operators within the sports facility.

Article 2 - Authorization and Accreditation

1. Access to sports facility is guaranteed for the purpose of exercising the right to report for the communication operators who are:
 - a) registered in the Register of communication operators; and / or
 - b) in possession of a newspaper registered with the Chancellery of the competent Court; and / or
 - c) authorized by the event organizer.
2. To obtain the authorization referred to in paragraph 1 above, the communication operator must complete the application according to the form prepared for this purpose by the Event organizer on the official website (www.dreamworldcup.net).
3. The authorization may be revoked by the Event organizer due to the loss of the requirements, with an adequately motivated provision.
4. The accreditation can be requested to the Event organizer by the communication operators for the members of the Register of professional journalists and / or publicists and / or practitioners, as well as for the technicians performing audio-visual recording activities.
5. For reasons of public order and safety, the Event organizer may limit the number of accreditations within the sports facility for the subjects indicated in paragraph 4 above.
6. Together with the application referred to in paragraph 2 above, the documents proving the possession of the requirements referred to in paragraph 1 must be delivered, together with personal data. The authorization is not transferable to third parties and loses its effectiveness if, during the Event for which it is issued, the communication operator ceases or suspends its activity for any reason.

Article 3 - Discipline of the Relationship between Media Operators and Event Organizer

1. The accredited subjects must occupy the positions assigned to them and are required to comply with the provisions on permanence within the facility specifically designed by the Event organizer.
2. Accredited subjects cannot make live recordings and streaming unless expressed authorized by the Event organizer.
3. Interviews may be conducted according to the provisions dictated by the Event organizer.

Article 4 - Control and Sanctioning Activities

1. The accredited subjects are required to respect the regulation of the relationship between the media and the Event organizer referred to in Article 3 of this Regulation.

2. The Event organizer is responsible for supervising and adopting the consequent provisions on the basis of its own regulations in case of non-compliance with the provisions adopted by the same organizer according to the preceding articles of this regulation.
